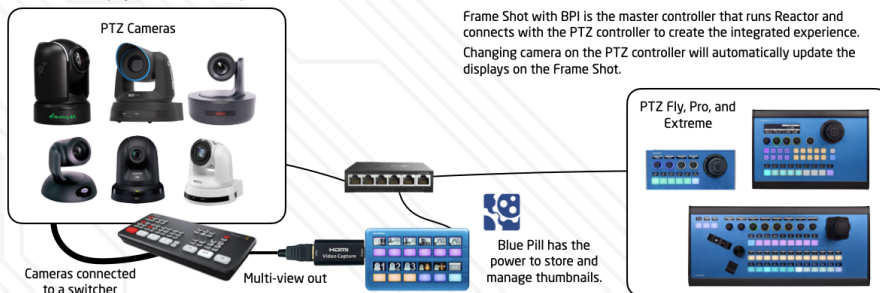

What to expect

Any PTZ camera can have visual thumbnails presented to operators for intuitive recall. No need to write positions down on paper anymore! Thumbnails are automatically captured via Frame Link (free software for Blue Pill) from a multi viewer input via web camera API grabber hardware. When presets are stored via the SKAARHOJ controller, the content from the camera designated multi-viewer window is captured and stored for display in the Frame Shot panel.



Model Support

- Web camera input to USB-2 port on Blue Pill
- Any HDMI multi-viewer with 2x2 or 4x4 configuration
- Frame Shot with Blue Pill Inside (BPI) and Frame Link Application
- PTZ Fly, PTZ Pro, or PTZ Extreme with UniSketch or BPI (free choice)

Configurations and Alternatives

- **"PTZ Fly + Frame Shot"** - Default configuration
 - **"PTZ Pro + Frame Shot"** - Default configuration
 - **"PTZ Extreme + Frame Shot"** - Default configuration
- Other SKAARHOJ PTZ solutions can work as well but may require custom configuration.
- Explore SKAARHOJ MKA1, MKA2, and MKA3 as an alternative: They can be combined into a modular PTZ controller with color thumbnails embedded.

Technical Notes

Frame Shot with BPI is the master controller that runs Reactor and connects with the PTZ controller to create the integrated experience. Changing camera on the PTZ controller will automatically update the displays on the Frame Shot.

Application Ideas

- Let a church volunteer use Frame Shot to recall preset positions during a service.

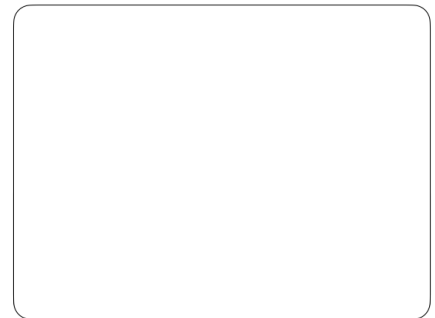
